Drama at Brandeston Hall

Drama is an exciting recent addition to the full curriculum at Brandeston Hall, with all children in Years 3 to 8 having one timetabled lesson a week with a specialist teacher. Children work in groups on a wide variety of themes to extend their communication, co-operation and performance skills.

Through active use of a range of Drama techniques children develop their own skills enabling them to gain confidence in public speaking, group and individual performance work, including monologue pieces and debating.

Drama sessions are planned to allow all children the chance to take part while providing ample opportunity to show leadership, demonstrate improving skills and take on new challenges. Children regularly share their work within class groups, and when appropriate, perform to a larger audience such as school assemblies.

We have built a tradition of excellent School Productions; details of which can be seen on this site. Children can take part in Senior and Junior Productions each year, as well as smaller performance pieces.
